1) **Pumping Report**:

The Public Works Director reported the following:

- o JR-1 well has been placed into service, now that the reservoir is no longer spilling over.
- o Transfer pumping has been suspended due to the level of the reservoir.
- Color level was up for the month of June.

- o North Reservoir is @ 54MG, usable storage-60MG.
- South Pond is @ capacity, usable storage-7MG

The Public Works Director reported the following:

- Lead and copper sample results have been received. Three homes were above the action level in this sampling round. We will contact the owners to inspect their plumbing to determine if there is a service line or goose neck that is contributing to their high levels. We will continue to work with Fay, Spofford and Thorndike to optimize treatment.
- Michael Crawford was hired as the new Assistant Superintendent for the Water Treatment Plant and will be starting 07/16/12.
