The only E-waste items collected through the State sponsored program are:

TVs, Monitors, Computers, Laptops and Tablets.

Drop-Off options for other E-waste items:

- **Staples:** Accepts computers, laptops, monitors, computer peripherals (keyboard, mouse, printer, etc) and many other old office technology products listed on website. Call ahead to confirm they will accept you item(s). Limit of seven items per household per day; NO TVs. (Wakefield 783-8127; Middletown 848-0100; www.staples.com/sbd/cre/marketing/sustainability-center/recycling-services/?icid=SustProducts:topnav:3:RECYCLE:)
- **Indie Cycle, LLC:** Hosts weekly collection events and accepts “anything that uses electricity” EXCEPT light bulbs. (indiecycle.blogspot.com) \$10 fee for televisions, monitors and printers.
- **Best Buy:** Accepts TVs, monitors, and other electronics, no matter where item was purchased – see website for full item list. Call ahead to confirm they will accept you item(s). Limit of three items per household per day. (Warwick 826-7007; www.bestbuy.com/recycling) \$25 for each TV or computer monitor.
- **ORS (Office Recycling Solutions):** Accepts computers, laptops, monitors, computer peripherals (keyboard, mouse, printers, etc), stereo equipment, DVD players, etc. Call ahead to confirm they will accept your items(s).
