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### **JAMESTOWN EXEMPTION NOTICE**

The Tax Assessor is now accepting applications for the following tax exemptions:

**DISABLED:** Residents under the age of 65, with annual incomes below \$25,000, who are determined to be totally disabled by the Social Security Administration. Also, veterans who have a 100% service-related disability and those who have specially adapted housing.

**ELDERLY:** Residents over the age of 65, with gross incomes below \$27,478 for a one person household; or below \$37,202 for a two person household.

**VISUALLY IMPAIRED:** Residents who are legally blind according to Rhode Island General Laws.

**VETERAN:** Honorably discharged veterans (or surviving spouses) who submit an application and a copy of the DD-214 discharge form.

**GOLD STAR PARENT:** Residents with a son or daughter who has died as the result of service in the armed forces.

Exemptions will apply to the 2019-20 tax roll. Applications must be filed by March 15, 2019.
