Minutes of the July 11, 2012 Jamestown Harbor Commission Meeting Approved: 8/8/2012

A meeting of the Jamestown Harbor Commission (JHC) was held Wednesday, July 11, 2012 at the Jamestown Town Hall, 93 Narragansett Avenue, Jamestown, Rhode Island.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MELLO'S REPORT

Executive Director Mello updated the Jamestown Harbor Commission on the status of the Maple Avenue kayak rack, stating that the town was able to build one for significantly less than the projected purchase cost.
