V. Old Business

Amendments to the Comprehensive Plan Build Out Analysis –

The majority of this work was done by the GIS Department and Public Works. Matt Bernardo and Andrew Aveledo were hired as interns this past summer. They both grew up in Jamestown and under the direction of Justin Jobin Environmental Scientist and GIS specialist for the Town of Jamestown spent some time working on this project.

Reduced total number of potential units over the last 10 years from 1133 to 733.

Commissioner Smith discussed water for these potential units. Commissioner Smith wants something in the Comprehensive Plan that states how much water is dumped over south pond, he wants that mentioned here. It was not supported by other members.

A discussion ensued regarding putting sewers in the north end of the island by Commissioner Smith. It was noted that URI recommended not having sewers in that area since the groundwater would not be recharged for well use.
