READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

REPORT OF TOWN OFFICIALS

1) **Pumping Report:**

The Public Works Director reported the following:

- JR-1 has been in service since May.
- Pumping was down for the month of August.
- Rainfall was low for the month of August.
- North Reservoir is @ 44MG, usable storage-60MG.
- South Pond is @ 6MG, usable storage-6MG

Commissioner Meagher asked the Public Works Director if he had any concerns regarding the lack of rainfall and restrictions. The Public Works Director stated the following:

- He is not concerned, as usage has dropped and it is the same pattern as last fall.
- The annual restrictions pertaining to lawn irrigation expired on August 31st and the next restriction would go into effect, when the reservoir reaches 42 inches below the spillway.
- The reservoir is currently 24 inches below the spillway.

2) Town project reports: (See Project Update Report dated August 2015)

Transfer pumping/Reservoir:

The Public Works Director reported the following:

- Transfer pumping was suspended when the water level dropped below the spillway.
- Staff has been mowing and maintaining the dam and reservoir properties.

Distribution System:

The Public Works Director reported that staff continues to work on the installation of the new water main between Green Lane and Howland Avenue.

Wastewater Treatment Plant:

The Public Works Director reported the he has provided a copy of the plans for the Sanitary Sewer Lining and Rehabilitation Project in the Commissions meeting packets. The Public Works Director briefly described the lining process and stated that the project was put out to bid and the bids have been received and reviewed. Due to a formality issue the project will be readvertised and re-bid.

Following clarification of a few items, it was the consensus of the Commission to accept the report of the Public Works Director, as presented.
