SUBJECT: Outdoor Seating-Restaurants

Please see the attached special event application as submitted by the Jamestown Chamber of Commerce. As you know, this is the result of Town staff working with the Chamber and various business owners in the Village area more specifically restaurants. The Governor has issued guidelines regarding outdoor service by restaurants beginning on May 18. Following several meetings with the involved parties, this is a summary of the plan as proposed in partnership with the Chamber.

I request that the Town Council approve the Special Event permit with a review date of June 15. By granting this permit, it will allow the participating restaurants to use Town space to offer outdoor seating. The hours of operation are left to the individual restaurants with an end time of 10 PM daily.

On the attached map, you will see the assigned areas of Town space. This includes space for the Narragansett Café, J22, and Angels Kitchen being assigned space with the Municipal parking lot. General's Crossing and Spinnaker's will each be allowed three parking spaces in front of their respective locations. Simpatico will be allowed four spaces in which no service will be allowed but will allow for greater social distancing.

Concrete jersey barriers will protect all areas.

I recommend that the following conditions be placed on all locations:

- Must meet DBR regulations related to COVID-19
- No outdoor entertainment
- No tents or pop-ups.
- Table umbrellas are permitted.
- Table service only-no outdoor bars allowed.
- Food and alcohol are permitted to tables only.
- Must maintain control methods to reduce "crowding"

All involved will reassess the permit and program by the June 15 Town Council meeting. At that meeting, we will be prepared to provide the Council with an updated report and further recommendation.

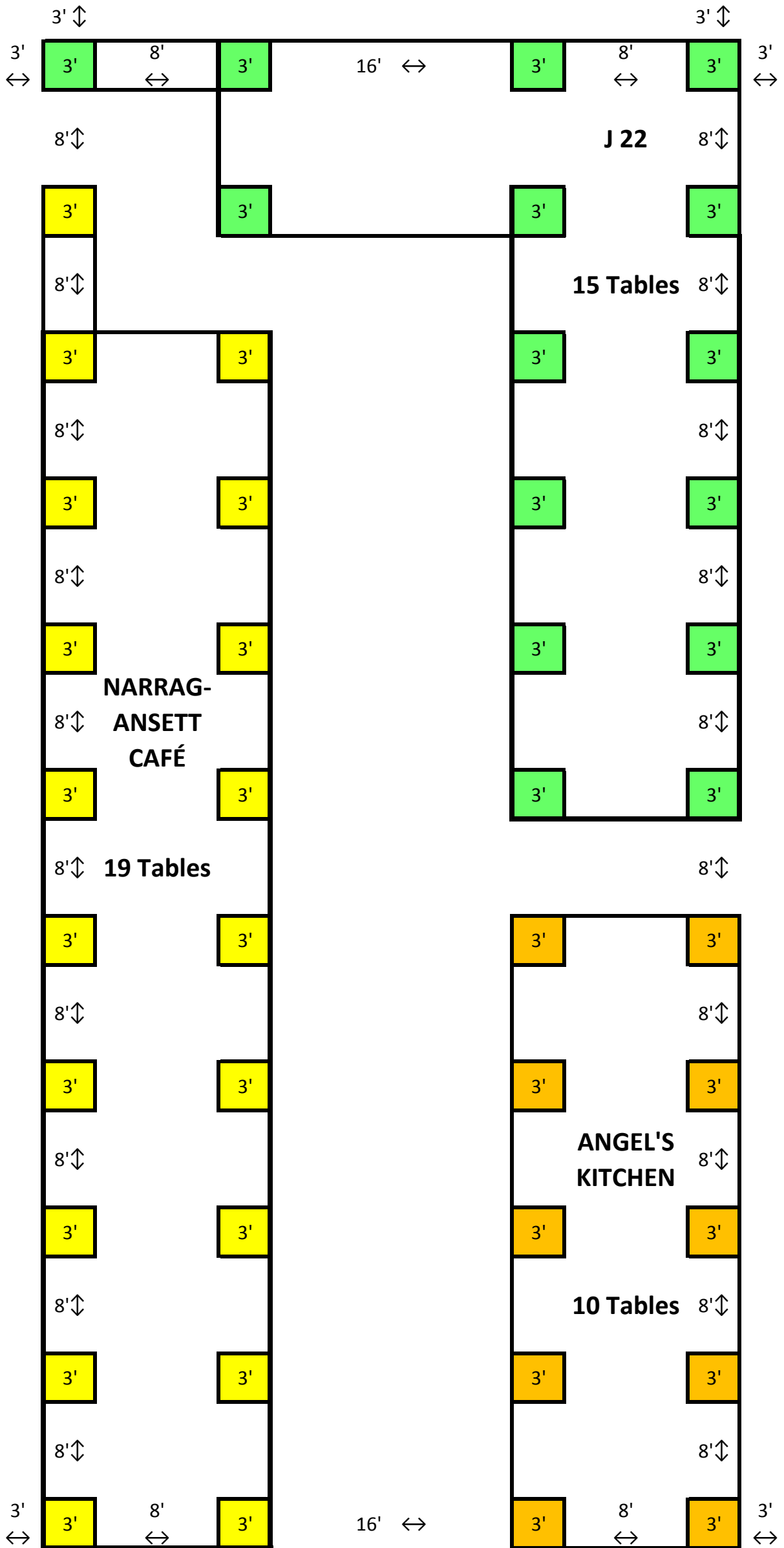

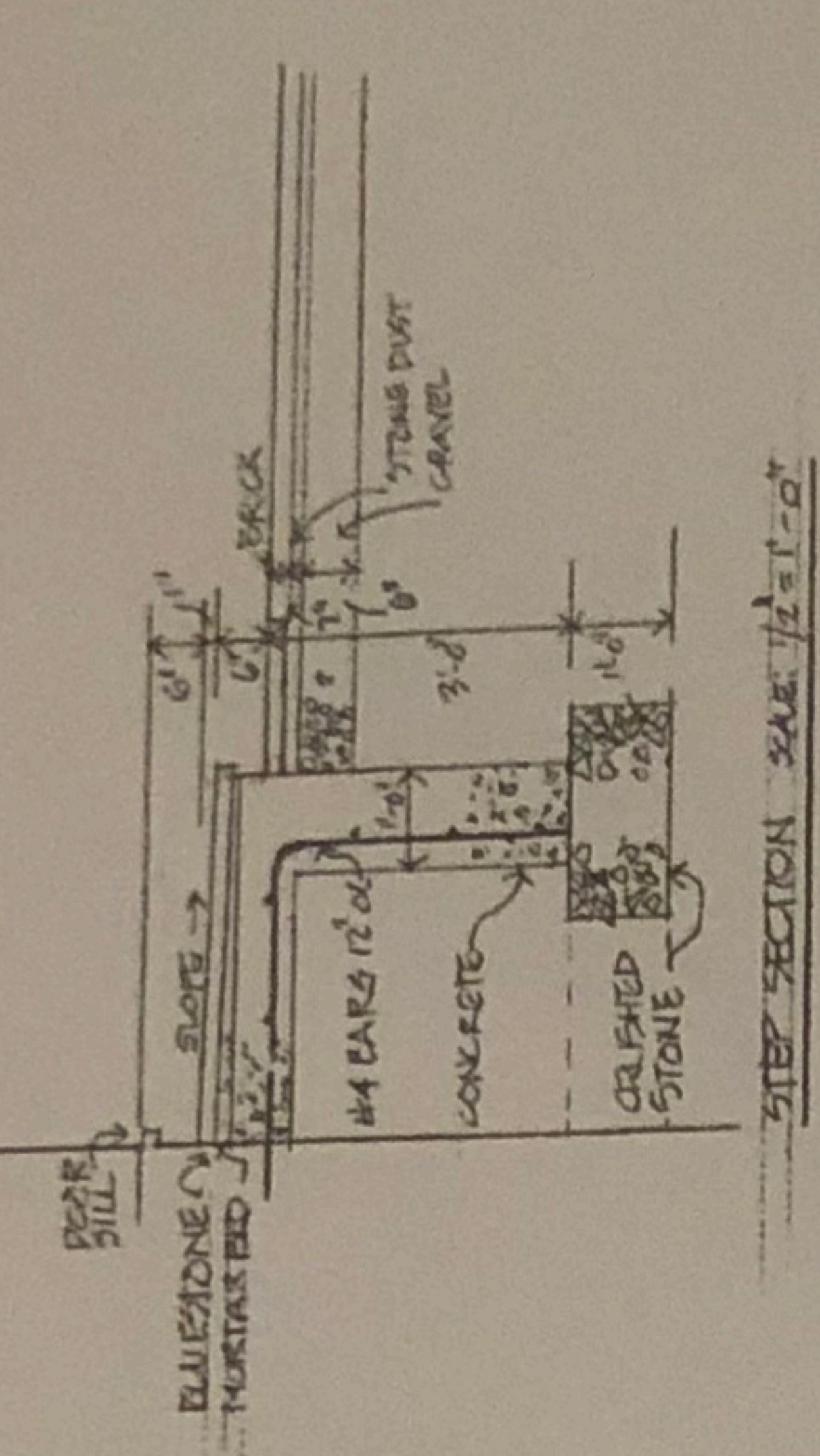

