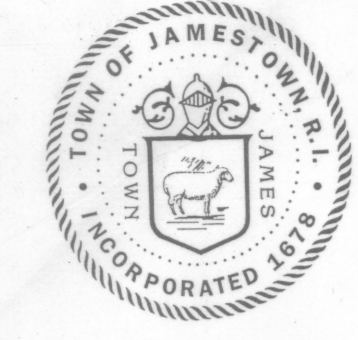

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On September 2, 1997, I located the rolled pieces of a version of the Conanicut Park plat in the lower level vault in the Jamestown Town Hall. This version bears the following handwritten inscription in the corner beneath where the topographical explanation is located:

"The Conanicut Land Company reserves the right to make changes in this plat as in their judgment shall be for the general interest of the stockholders and lot owners. Commercial, Middle, Fairview and Hopkins Streets are taken up and the land not platted may be laid out at any future time by the Company.

Newport, SS. June 16, 1873. Then the above Lucius D. Davis Treasurer of the Conanicut Land Company personally appeared and acknowledged the foregoing instrument by him submitted to be his free act and deed in his official capacity as Treasurer of said Company, and the free act and deed of said Company.

The inscription is accompanied by the embossed seals of "Conanicut Land Company" and "Benjamin Marsh 2., Notary Public, Newport R.I.". It also bears the inscription "DRAWN BY JOHN H. MULLIN, Topographical Engineer, NEWPORT, R.I., MARCH, 1873".

Although very similar to the print housed in Hanging Plat File #6A, as copied by "R J EASTON & SON C.E. NEWPORT R I FEB 11 1928", it is not identical. It is in deplorable condition and is not available for public use until such time that it has been restored.
