

northerly in a straight line, making an interior angle of $93^{\circ}-26'-30''$ with said property division line, for a distance of one hundred ninety-seven and twenty-five one-hundredths (197.25) feet to a point in the southerly face of a stone wall running in an easterly-westerly direction; thence easterly in a straight line along the southerly face of said stone wall, making an interior angle of $91^{\circ}-45'-50''$ with the last described line, for a distance of eighty-nine and eighty one-hundredths (89.80) feet to its intersection with the westerly face of a stone wall running in a northerly-southerly direction; thence southerly in a straight line along the westerly face of said stone wall, making an interior angle of $88^{\circ}-14'-10''$ with the last described line, for a distance of one hundred ninety-three and nine one-hundredths more or less (193.09±) feet to its intersection with the northerly boundary line of Eldred Ave., so-called; thence easterly along the northerly boundary line of Eldred Ave., so-called, to its intersection with the northerly highway line of Eldred Ave., so-called, as established by Plat No. 645 by the aforesaid Rhode Island Department of Public Works and filed in the office of the Town Clerk of Jamestown on December 21, 1939, said point of intersection being opposite and forty-five more or less (45±) feet northerly from said traverse line at Sta. 52+91±.

Also beginning at a point, said point being at the first described point opposite and forty-five (45) feet southerly from said traverse line at Sta. 13+21±; thence southeasterly in a straight line to a point, said point being opposite and forty-five (45) feet southerly from the tangent line of the first described curve at a point one hundred ninety (190) feet southeasterly from the point of curvature of said curve; thence easterly
