Announcing the fifth meeting of the Gould Island Restoration Advisory Board on November 12

CONCORD, Mass. – The fifth meeting of the Gould Island Restoration Advisory Board is scheduled for Thursday, November 12, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. Due to COVID-19 concerns, this will be a virtual “Zoom” meeting. The Town of Jamestown has offered to support the RAB by hosting the Zoom meeting and will provide connection details on its RAB website at the URL noted below.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New England District, working with residents of Jamestown and the surrounding area, established a Restoration Advisory Board to support the Corps environmental investigation activities at Gould Island in Narragansett Bay.

The RAB was established to facilitate in providing information to the local community and to provide an avenue to address recommendations and concerns regarding the potential impacts the project may have on the community. Membership of the RAB board has been established and the public at large is invited to attend the meeting. The board serves as a point of contact between the community and the Corps.
