Minutes of the July 10, 2013 Meeting of the Jamestown Harbor Commission Approved: 8/15/2013

A meeting of the Jamestown Harbor Commission (JHC) was held Wednesday, July 10, 2013 at the Jamestown Town Hall, 93 Narragansett Avenue, Jamestown, Rhode Island.

Mr. Gary Parker addressed the Jamestown Harbor Commission regarding the CMS expansion plans. Mr. Parker is a mooring permit holder with a mooring located in the potential path of the marina expansion. The moorings located in the potential expansion area have been there for 35-40 years and are in shallow water and inexpensive to maintain and the permit holders in the area are not keen on being relocated to a different spot.

Mr. Vic Calabretta addressed the Jamestown Harbor Commission regarding the Conanicut Yacht Club (CYC) request for additional moorings.

Chairman deAngeli moved to move up item 14(B), Commissioner Cain seconded. So voted (5 ayes, 0 nays).

Mr. Calabretta continued that the reason for the request is the need for coach boats for the junior sailing program. The CYC is requesting nine additional commercial moorings for their club.

Mr. Calabretta also notified the Jamestown Harbor Commission of a vessel blocking the CYC dock, and asked the mooring be relocated to an area that does not interfere with the Yacht Club dock.

Chairman deAngeli requested Harbormaster Paterson assess the situation and determine if there is space to fulfill the CYC request.

Executive Director Chief Mello reported both boats are in the water and operational and things are going well.

Chairman deAngeli asked how the dock repairs at East Ferry are going.
